Cancellation policy

If you would like to use the freely available digital offers of Süddeutsche Zeitung GmbH and have concluded a **contract with advertising** with us, Süddeutsche Zeitung GmbH, for this purpose, you have a right of withdrawal as a consumer pursuant to Section 355 of the German Civil Code.

A "consumer" within the meaning of this cancellation policy is any natural person who enters into a legal transaction for purposes that are predominantly neither commercial nor self-employed.

You have the right to withdraw this contract with advertising without giving any reason. The withdrawal period is 14 days. It begins with the conclusion of the contract.

To exercise your right of withdrawal, you must inform us by means of a clear declaration of your decision to withdraw this contract. This is done

by clicking on the "withdrawal" link in the footer under readers without subscription.

To comply with the withdrawal period, it is sufficient that you send the notification of the exercise of the right of withdrawal before the expiry of the withdrawal period.
